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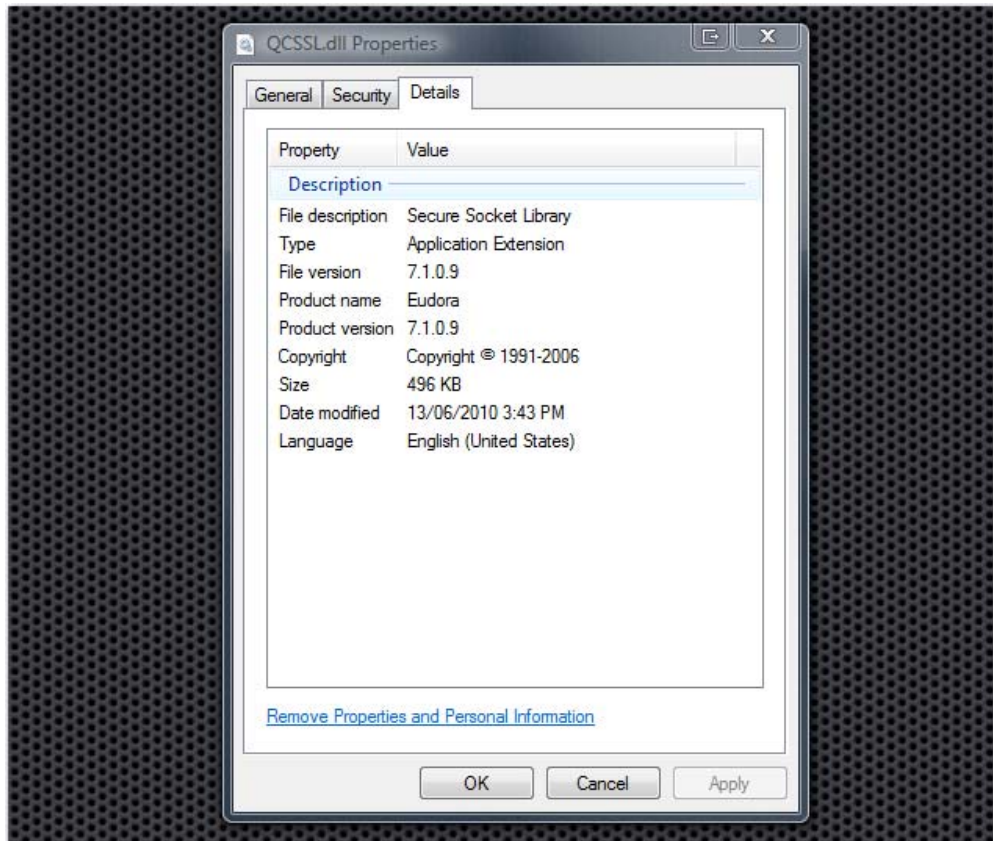

*Eudora is now abandoned ware so while it still exists the company no longer supports it and has tried to nobble it by corrupting a DLL file in it's still available download of Eudora 7.1. However with this you can get it for free, fix it by replacing the one DLL file and register it with the provided PRO serial and there you have it, it's yours legally! It so much better than Outlook and the best thing is that to back it up you just copy it's entire folder, move, reinstall as normal and then paste the copied folder over the new installation and your right to go, BRILLIANT!*

All the background posts are, I am certain, essential to those of you doing the problem solving. And, especially thank you to jhmeyers ("How to patch...") for developing a clear, understandable, and flawless "step-by-step" that I was able to follow very easily. I don't mean it to be condescending when I say "You communicate very well for a hacker!"

I was looking for a way to add tags to the thread which would have helped me find it through a search without jhmeyers' help. Tags I would add: checkmail, check, mail, startup, delay

Users of version 7.1.0.9 can overcome this even more easily, by downloading the zip file attached to the prior post about hex editing, which contains the already-patched **QCSSL.dll** file for version 7.1.0.9

The "fc /b" command mentioned in that prior post may be used to compare the original file with the patched file, to verify that only the correct single byte has been modified, to make sure that no one has "hacked in" and substituted any malware.

Thank you for appreciating the technical writing; it has only taken about four decades of continual practice 😊

And thanks again to "JCF" (who figured out exactly what patch was needed, by deep analysis of both OpenSSL source code and Eudora program modules).

This patch is applicable only to recent versions of Classic Eudora for Windows (versions 6.2[.3?]) that experiencing the problem of a long delay upon the very first SSL connection to the very first SSL-enabled perform the steps below. Some currently available, free hex editors for Windows:

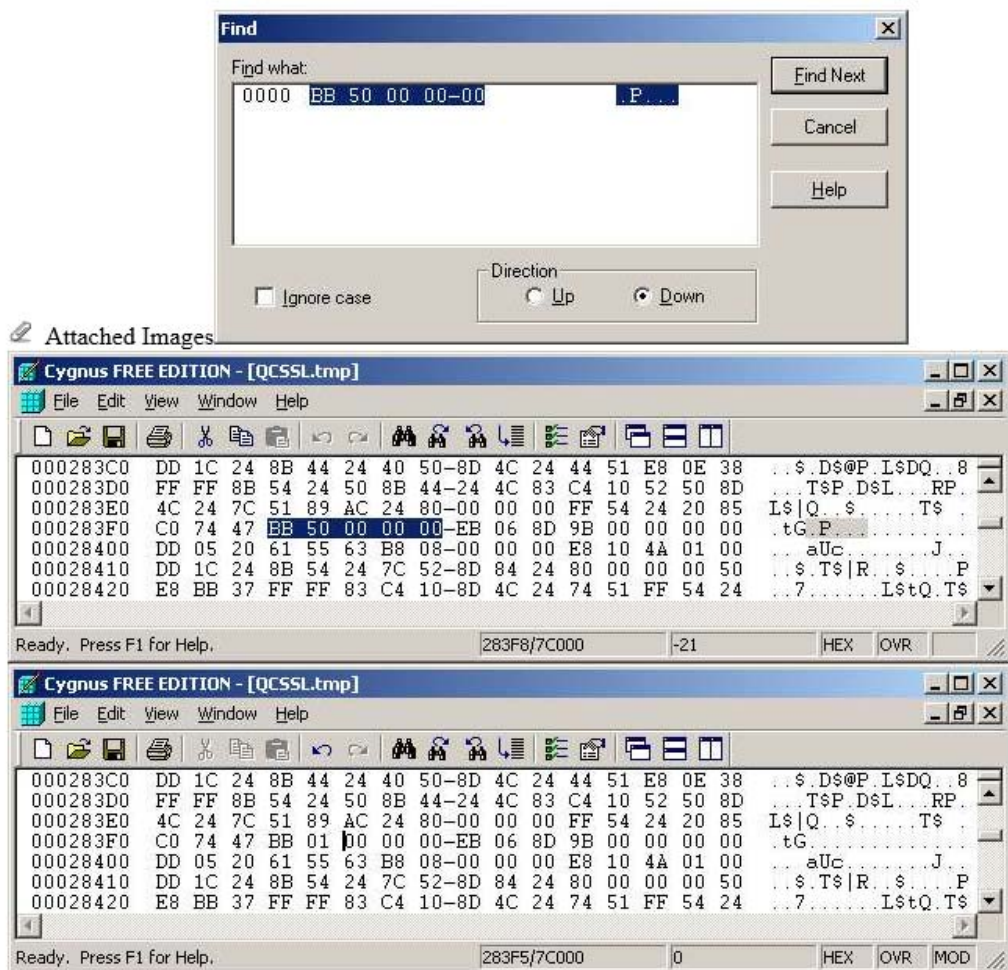

Close the Eudora application before processing "QCSSL.dll" file by selecting it, then perform Ctrl+C (Copy) followed by Ctrl+V (Paste). Right-click "QCSSL.tmp" Right-click and open the "Properties" of "QCSSL.tmp" and clear any "Read-only" property to the shortcut for launching the editor, or to the already-open window of your editor, or use the "File" steps below in the Cygnus hex editor mentioned above (other hex editors may differ slightly): Use "Edit" BB 50 00 00 00 (just type the characters "bb50000000" and this editor will expand them) Repeat the steps that there is only one location where this sequence is found. Type: BB01 (to overwrite "BB 50" with "BB01" that your typing wrote over the original bytes, and did not insert anything (the original "BB 50 00 00 00" or about. "Save" the correctly edited file. Make sure that the edited file and the original file are still the "Properties," and viewing the "Size" property (this may be different from "Size on disk") The correct file is 507,904 bytes An ideal way to check for proper editing is to open a "command prompt" (cmd.exe), go to the edited files (usually C:\Program Files\Qualcomm\Eudora), then type and run the following command:

```
fc/b qcssl.dll qcssl.tmp
```

The correct output for Eudora version 7.1 is: Comparing files QCSSL.dll and QCSSL.TMP 000283F4 "50" to hex "01") After verifying proper editing, rename:

```
QCSSL.dll -> QCSSL.original QCSSL.tmp -> QCSSL.dll
```

Eudora is now patched, and should make the first SSL connection much faster. Thanks to "JCF" for the
